### **Abstract:**

Although demand for tertiary education is increasing dramatically, students are increasingly disengaged in the classroom due to their many outside commitments and a classroom experience that only partially addresses their digital literacy and highly social approach to communication and learning.

The **myLearningSpace** project aims to address this gap, and provide a platform upon which to deliver a variety of highly engaging learning and teaching experiences that incorporate general services and discipline-specific tasks and activities. The project has been successfully piloted at Gippsland in the School of Applied Sciences and Engineering in Semester Two this year, as well as a previous pilot at Clayton in Semester One. Further pilots are being planned for 2009.

What would it look like if every student was part of the conversation in your lectures and tutorials in a way that improves engagement, learning and teacher satisfaction?
